

MEMORANDUM-DIRECTIONS OF THE PRESIDING OFFICER

1. On the 4th and 5th of March 2015, the Tribunal heard further evidence relating to the Wai 2490 urgent claims.
2. At the end of the proceedings, claimant counsel raised the possibility of the Tribunal releasing a "truncated" report and asked if the Tribunal would like to receive submissions on this. I stated that the Tribunal would review the Statement of Issues to see if any consolidation could be achieved.
3. The Tribunal has since revised the Statement of Issues to better reflect the range of issues discussed at the hearings and submitted in evidence.
4. The revised Statement of Issues will be placed on Wai 2490 Record of Inquiry as Wai 2490, #1.4.2. Parties are to reference this revised version in their closing submissions.
5. The Tribunal now awaits closing submissions and will update parties in due course on the status of the report.
