



**Summary of First Round of Road Show Hui hosted by
Te Runanga A Iwi O Ngapuhi
April & May 2009**

Ngapuhi held 13 road show hui throughout Aotearoa New Zealand, and one in Sydney, during April and May 2009 to discuss a proposed comprehensive Treaty settlement.

Altogether, more than 800 Ngapuhi attended from Hokianga in the North to Murihiku in the South.

Raniera (Sonny) Tau and Erima Henare led the hui and were supported by Te Runanga A Iwi O Ngapuhi staff.

The purpose of the road show hui was to promote discussion with the Ngapuhi nation on a proposed settlement with the Crown for breaches of Te Tiriti o Waitangi.

The key issues arising from the road show hui were:

- Hapu need to decide how they want to be represented during the settlement process
- The role of Te Runanga A Iwi O Ngapuhi representatives is to facilitate discussion
- The importance of the Ngapuhi people being kept informed of progress
- Any settlement would be between the Crown and Iwi, not individual claimants

A further round of road show hui, to follow up on discussions from the April and May hui, will begin in September.
