
MEMORANDUM-DIRECTIONS OF THE PRESIDING OFFICER

1. On 13 February 2015, the Tribunal issued memorandum-directions confirming the timetable for filing closing submissions in writing (#2.5.56).
2. On 23 March 2015, claimant counsel filed a memorandum seeking an extension to file their closing submissions on 5pm, 25 March 2015 and their reply closing submissions on 10 April 2015.
3. Crown counsel did not oppose the request and asked that if the request was granted their filing deadline be extended until 5pm, Wednesday 8 April 2015. Given the Easter holiday period, this date would preserve the number of working days they were originally afforded to respond.
4. In light of the Crown's reply, claimant counsel sought a further amendment to the proposed filing date for reply claimant submissions (from 10 April 2015, to 15 April 2015).
5. This request is granted and the revised filing dates are as follows:

Claimant counsel and counsel for interested parties in support to file their submissions in reply	5pm, Friday 15 April 2015
