

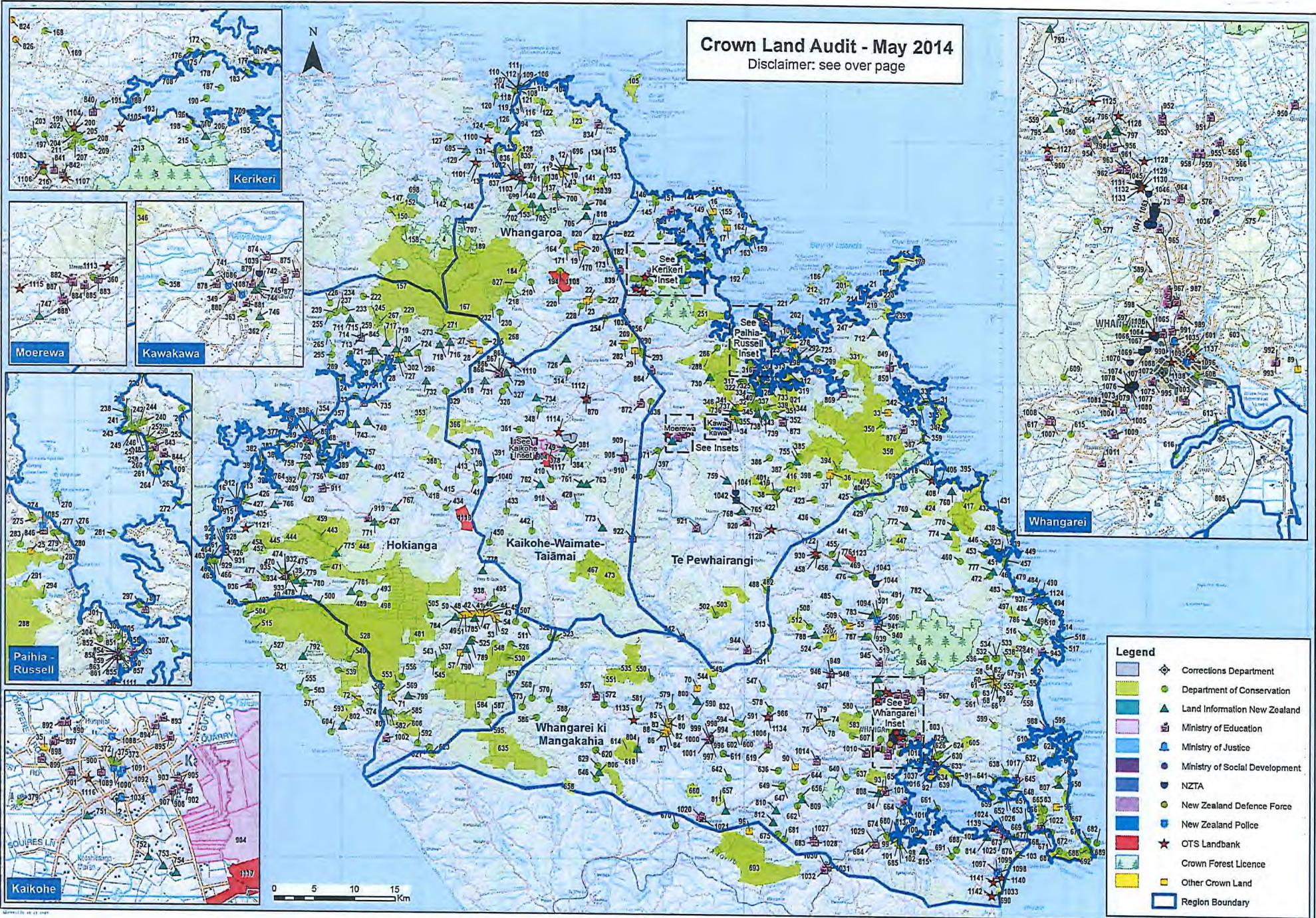

This Crown land audit:

- a) Reflects a preliminary understanding of Crown land holdings within this area without site-by-site confirmation or analysis by administering agencies;
- b) Is based on the best available data as at May 2014; and
- c) Does not signal the Crown's intention to transfer or otherwise extinguish ownership of Crown lands through future Treaty settlements in the region.

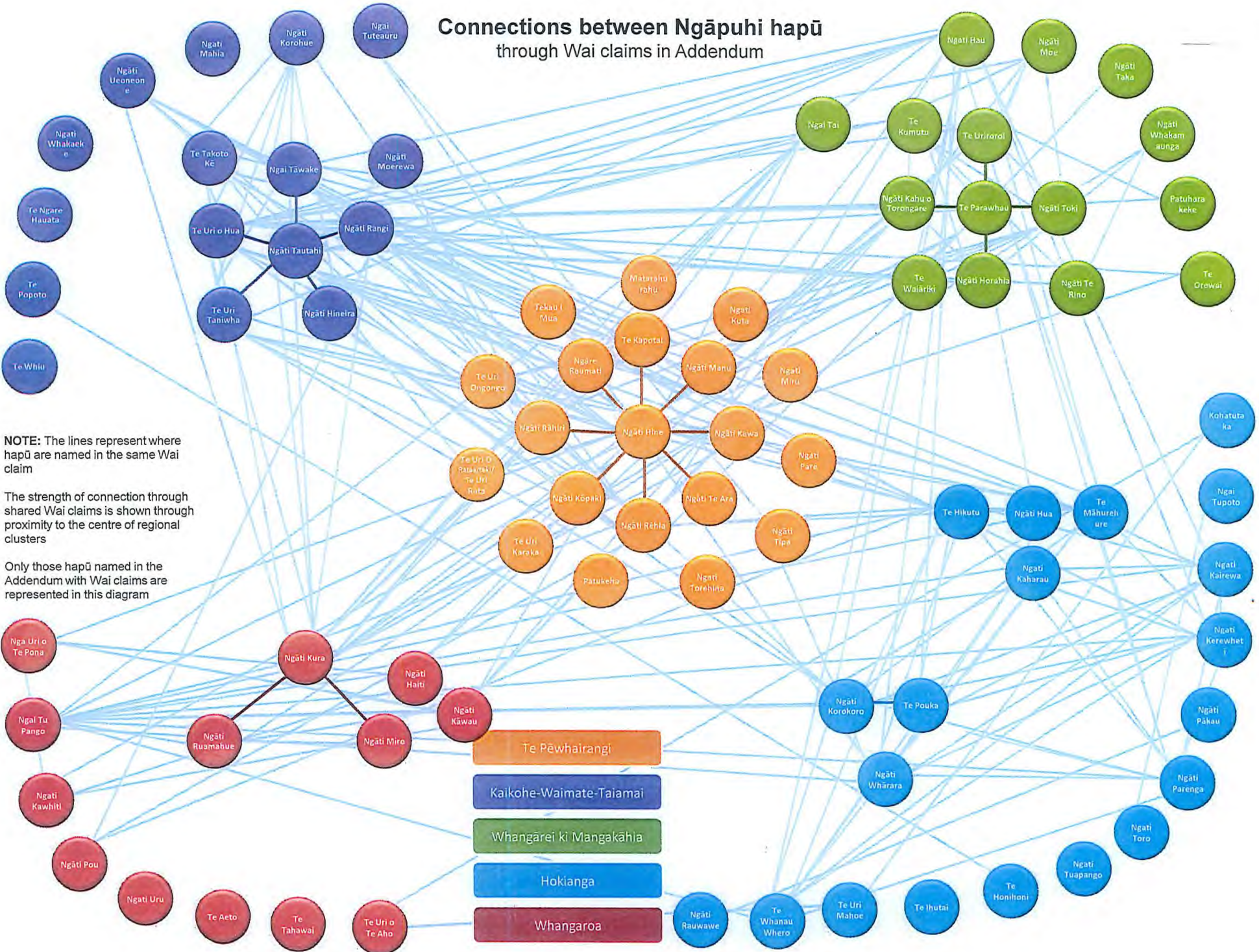
Not all lands within this audit will be available for Treaty settlement purposes and those lands that are will be subject to a range of redress options, which may include transfer of ownership.

The Crown will explore potential options for redress during negotiations. Where land is identified as a priority for settlement purposes, specific redress would be negotiated within Crown policy and operational parameters.

Certain redress may not be available over certain categories of properties. The Crown may ask for indications of specific sites and types of redress sought, as certain redress (such as leaseback redress) will only be explored in relation to a limited number of sites and not across Crown holdings as a whole.

The release of this audit is not intended to create any expectation as to what may or may not be negotiated as part of future Treaty settlements.
